Summary

In June 2023, CYAN released a report that reviewed and assessed current tobacco use policies on 258 public and private colleges and universities in the state.

The purpose of the Report is to reveal tobacco use policy trends on campuses in California. Additionally, the aim of the Report Card is to educate and encourage college decision makers to adopt comprehensive smoke and tobacco-free policies that promote health and wellness for all members of their campus community.

Smoke and Tobacco-Free Policy Rationale

Why college and university policies go 100% smoke and tobacco-free:

- Decrease exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol
- Decrease tobacco product use
- Eliminate tobacco product waste on campus
- Promote student success
- Eliminate exposure to new and emerging tobacco and nicotine products

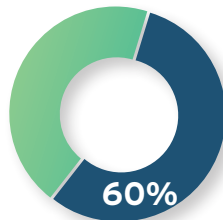
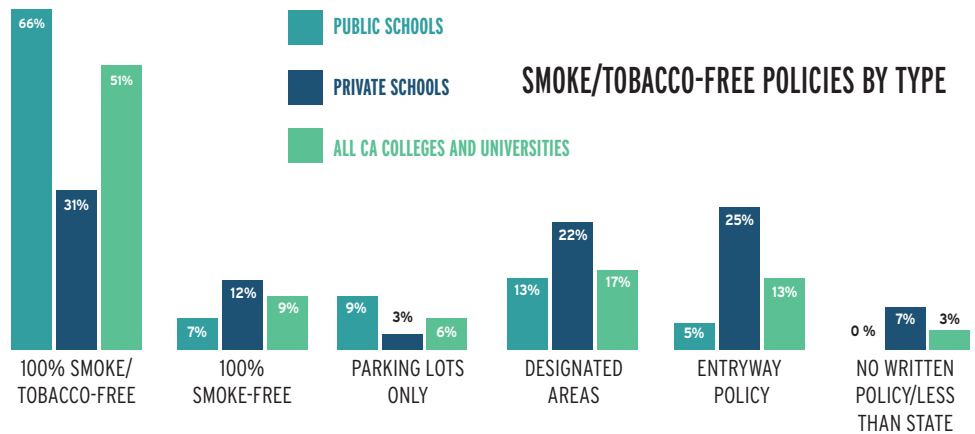

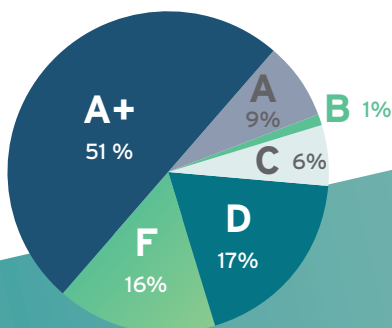
