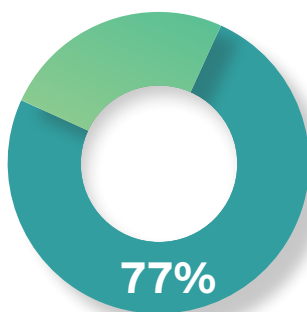

Hispanic-Serving College Summary

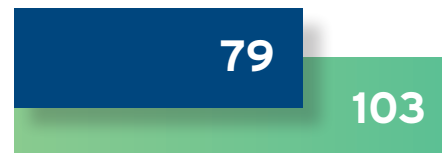
Annually, the California Youth Advocacy Network (CYAN) releases a report analyzing smoke and tobacco-free policies at colleges and universities in the state.

As of May 2023, 60% of public and private colleges and universities in California were 100% smoke or tobacco-free.

This Summary Report highlights findings from **Hispanic-serving** public and private institutions of higher education.

Why college and university policies go 100% smoke/tobacco-free:

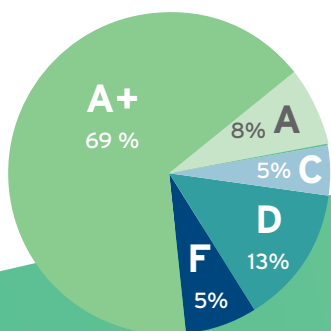
- Decrease exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol
