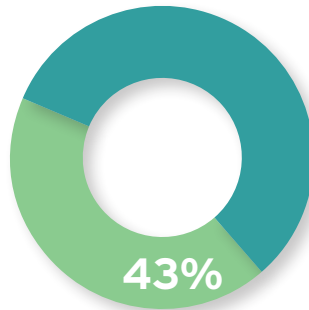

The Report reviews and assesses current tobacco use policies on 109 private colleges and universities that are active members of the Association of Independent California Colleges and Universities.

The purpose of this Report is to reveal tobacco use policy trends on campuses in California. Additionally, the aim of the Report Card is to educate and encourage college decision makers to adopt comprehensive smoke/tobacco-free policies that promote health and wellness for all members of their campus community.



PRIVATE CAMPUSES THAT ARE SMOKE OR TOBACCO-FREE



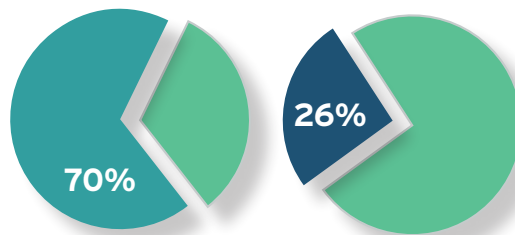

Smoke/Tobacco-Free Policy Rationale

Why college and university policies go 100% smoke/tobacco-free:

- Decrease exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol
- Decrease tobacco product use
- Eliminate tobacco product waste on campus
- Promote student success
- Eliminate exposure to new and emerging tobacco and nicotine products

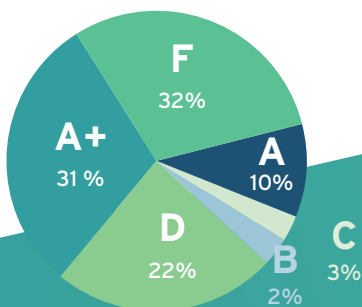
