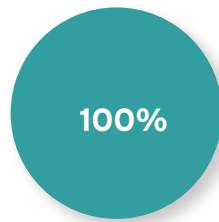

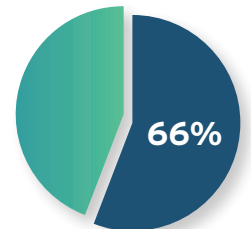
## 100% SMOKE -OR- TOBACCO-FREE POLICIES

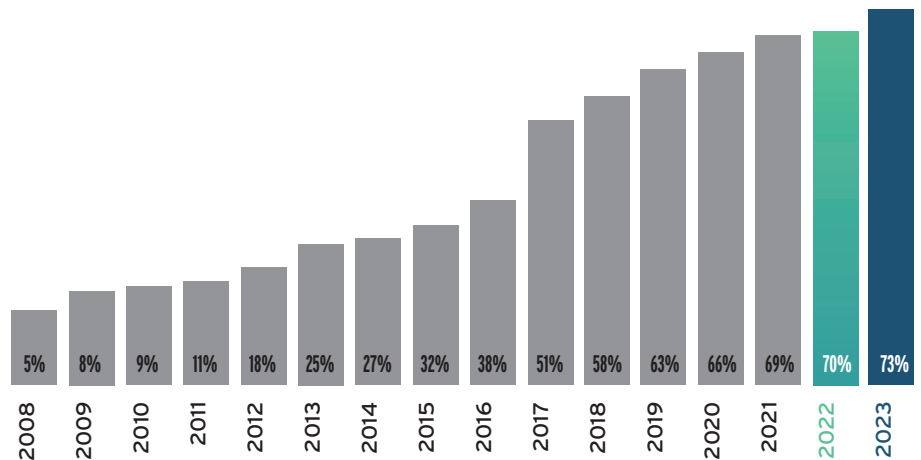

Why college and university policies go 100% smoke/tobacco-free:

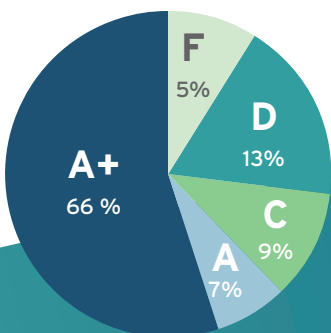
- Decrease exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol
