Summary

The Report reviews and assesses current tobacco use policies on all 148 public colleges and universities in the state.

The purpose of this Report is to reveal tobacco use policy trends on campuses in California. Additionally, the aim of the Report Card is to educate and encourage college decision makers to adopt comprehensive smoke/tobacco-free policies that promote health and wellness for all members of their campus community.

Smoke/Tobacco-Free Policy Rationale

- Decrease Exposure to Secondhand Smoke
- Decrease Commercial Tobacco Use
- Eliminate Tobacco Waste on Campus
- Prepare students for a Commercial Tobacco-free Work Environment
- Decrease Exposure to New and Emerging Commercial Tobacco and Nicotine Products




